

CANADA REDS CRITICAL

Party Organ Carries Attack on Soviet by Ex-Leader

TORONTO, Ont., Oct. 26—

The Soviet Government is under fire by leaders of the Labor-Progressive (Communist) party in both Ontario and Quebec provinces.

The current issue of the party's official organ, The Canadian Tribune, carries a lengthy letter from Gui Caron, who quit as leader of the Quebec branch of the Labor-Progressive party last week along with five other members of the Quebec executive.

Mr. Caron said the report of Nikita S. Khrushchev, Soviet Communist party chief, to the closed session of the 'twentieth congress of the Communist party in Moscow had "revealed a picture much more akin, in its cruelty, to medieval absolutism, the inquisition or the Nazi Gestapo than to anything else."
