Beyond this, we can not say...this will depend on both: 1) Objective Factors - wars & the danger of World War, militarization of the economy, the growing police state fascism, developments concerning the economic crisis at the base, the mass spontaneous movements, world events, & so on; and 2) Subjective Factors - how quickly & how well we found, consolidate & further build our Party, how quickly & how well the masses become class-conscious fighters & recognize our Party as their one & only leading Party, how quickly & how well they are organized into mass organizations led by the Party, how quickly & how well the Party proletarianizes itself further, & unites the class & then the masses in the United Front, & so on. The Party's work will influence the "Objective Factors" greatly.
