Some comrades have asked us to explain the epithet CRIMINAL, applied to the puppet Nikita Khrushchev. We do so willingly since, from the time this dishonest grubby person took power we have denounced his intrigues and CRIMES.

Khrushchev was a criminal, as were those who followed him blindly, in the way in which he delivered his country to the Americans, buying their wheat and paying for it in GOLD, sending it overseas in many planeloads. Because of his stupidity and irresponsibility, the Soviet people knew the bitterness and shame of having to buy wheat from the worst enemy of Socialism, i.e., American imperialism. However, this is only a small matter compared to others.

The policy of PEACEFUL COEXISTENCE, as preached and practiced by Khrushchev is a crime, a surrender. Through compromise and concessions, the master of the Kremlin sold his country which, until then, was such a glorious one; his disciples eased him out, for fear of being pushed into the precipice, had they waited a little longer before acting. However, they already were on the edge of the chasm and the evil which has already been done is almost irreparable.

Khrushchev was a criminal when betraying the people's republic of Albania and violating treacherously the agreements signed with this country. The Albanian comrades did not give

up and their heroism earned them the admiration and respect of the entire world. Nikita, the so-called Communist, who lived like a millionaire, thought that he could bring the valorous People's Albania to its knees. His devious plans failed and we are grateful to the government and people of Albania, to the Labor Party of this friendly country for having resisted with such perspicacity and courage the blackmail and threats of the dictator.

Khrushchev was a criminal when he soiled the memory of the great comrade STALIN, trying to make him hated by the peoples. When Nikita the clown attacked STALIN, it was LENIN he attacked. Trying to climb on top of the ladder of Soviet heroes, and making himself into the infallible, the true, the great man of the revolution, he set up, in his favor, a true cult of his personality and gave many key positions to relatives or friends. He made Stalin responsible for all the ills of the country, even ten years after his death, whereas it was his incredibly irresponsible policy that was the only one responsible for the current situation of the USSR. Khrushchev used all possible means to take credit, to destroy the work of Stalin. Did he not even take Stalin's place in some motion pictures or history writings, in some statements which have remained unforgettable? It is doubtful that those shameful tricks have made proud the friends and disciples of this greatest of dissidents of all times.

Capitulating many times to the demands of the imperialists, Khrushchev betrayed not only the Soviet Union but the entire international Communist movement. The example of his behavior toward CUBA, among many others, equally serious, is flagrant. He displayed a dangerous adventurism by erecting his missiles in CUBA. However, removing them by order of the ambitious KENNEDY, he gave a real proof of CAPITULATION. He seriously endangered the republic of CUBA, its valorous government and the entire friendly Cuban people. He played with fire in a thoughtless and criminal manner.

Khrushchev the Communist who had his private Italian tailor, a royal suite and millionaire-style villas, who spoke without rhyme or reason, who promised the moon and happiness to his people while betraying them, on the other hand, so rakishly, who sympathized and treated with the imperialists, who pinned decorations to dictators of the Nasser type, who delivered weapons to the enemies of friendly China or to governments which massacred the **Communists**, is this man not a CRIMINAL? Is he not the author or, in any case, one of the accomplices in the plot against STALIN which ended with the murder of this

great follower of Lenin's work? What happened to Comrade MALENKOV? Has anyone seen him alive, just once? We have the right to ask this question, for serious suspicions weigh on the Khrushchev clique as regards the fate of Comrade Malenkov. What did Khrushchev do with the faithful revolutionary comrade and comrades in arms of Lenin and Stalin? Did he not eliminate them, physically or in fact, from any position of responsibility in the country? Was this not done for the purpose of being able, without difficulty, to betray and trick, while awarding himself undeserved laurels?

Where are the great achievements promised the Soviet people at workers' meetings or generously liquored banquets? Was this great worted speaker aware of what he promised, or did he think that good promises make the fools happy?

For the time being, we are quite mistrustful of the successors of Nikita, the scaly ant-eater, and their assurances that they will continue the policy of "peaceful co-existence" is not very reassuring. Such a policy, if pursued, would inevitably end with the total rout and defeat of those practicing it. Declaring themselves, spontaneously, the supporters of this line, the leaders of the **Swiss** Labor Party (PST-POP) are displaying, once again, their blind obedience to anything coming out of Moscow, and their own abandonment of the struggle. After 20 years of existence, that party could have brought us another gift, another way to a slow death . . . The loss of all revolutionary and Marxist spirit means the loss of the reason for existing, the means of existence. This means dying a very slow death. PEACEFUL COEXISTENCE is synonymous with CAPITULATION, treason, at least in the meaning given to it by the Khrushchevites.

We, nevertheless, hope that a self criticism based on the principles of Marxism-Leninism will take place both within the Central Committee of the Communist Party of the USSR as well as in other parties and that the renegades trained at Khrushchev aardward's school will go back to the right line they have lost and that the strayed sheep will join the herd. Courage and honesty must triumph, and truth come out. When the respected comrade STALIN was at the head of the Soviet Union no such problems existed. The international Communist movement, guided by a master who could provide it with concrete examples, was a tremendous and respected force, a force that was absolutely UNITED. Would it be possible to return to the true MARXIST-LENINIST line? This would be the only possibility to regain the UNITY among **Communists** throughout the world.

Speaking of criminals, let us drop the subject of Khrushchev the warted saimiri, and mention another low individual, at the expense of being reprimanded. However, the cloth does not make the monk, goes the saying, and, as far as we are concerned, we consider the pope and his under-popes as nothing but men since all the rest is usurpation and superstition, carefully maintained.

What to say about those popes who blessed Mussolini's cannons and his legal murderers before they were sent to battle where they massacred everything wherever they went, stealing and raping? What to say of those popes who award their highest medals to dictators-murderers such as FRANCO? What to say of this aristocratic, scornful and selfish aristocratic pope who shut his eyes, and his mouth, at the horrible Nazi crimes, the murders committed by the SS in concentration camps and elsewhere, affecting millions of human beings, whether Jews or not? We are taught that complicity is punishable and failure to help people in danger is equally condemnable. Pius XII died in peace; his gold did not prevent his death. However, why was he not tried and condemned as well? Even if he could not avoid those crimes, he could have, at least, acted. His silence was an encouragement for the Hitlerites.

What about this filthy scoundrel named Moise Tshombe? He is not, also, one of the most perfect types of a criminal? What are his hired assassins doing? What has he stolen from the Congolese people? Where has he taken his people?

And to think that there are people arduously defending those popes and this confounded Tshombe. There are idiocies that must be denounced. A scribbler in a reactionary conservative-social-CHRISTIAN newspaper became the heroic and passionate defender of such individuals, of Pius XII and of his beloved Tshombe. This man, M. Moser, who also calls himself P. Alian, is either naive or an incompetent or else of ill faith. He considers not to be "a sardine in oil." Well! Remains to be seen. . . Pius XII, Franco-Mussolini-Tshombe and Moser . . . all very good Christians, bravo!
