BLACK CAPITALISM AND WHAT IT MEANS

While reading the paper the other day, I saw where Oakland has been made a target area for tricky Dick Nixon's BLACK CAPITALISM PLAN. It seems to me that a further analysis of capitalism in general and black capitalism in particular seems to be forthcoming. When we check the history of various countries on this planet we find that many nations and races have gone through a capitalist bag. When we check Russian history we find that with the ending of the rule of the Czar, Russian capitalism came to an end. EDITORIAL STATEMENT BY BIG MAN, CO-EDITOR

In dealing with the question of renegades, the Black Panther Party checks out Chairman Mao and China's are renegade Lin-Shao-Chi.

Former members of the Black Panther Party who have been classified as renegades choose to draw their terminology as to what renegade really means from Webster's abridged "pocket" dictionary of course this is extreme narrowmindedness.

The Black Panther Party draws its conclusions from successfully practiced theories and examples. We learn from Chairman Mao that, kneeling before the enemy for allowing him a despicable life, a renegade is a criminal to history, a mangy dog that wags its tail in asking pardon from the enemy at the cost of betraying the revolution and the comrades. In depicting a renegade from the proletarian stand, one must expose his base and vile soul, condemn his crimes of betraying the people and the revolution and repudiate the decadent renegade philosophy which puts survival above everything.

When he kills people, a pirate excuses himself with the logic of a pirate; a renegade also has his theory for defending himself. China's prime example of a renegade says, "a man representing the proletariat . . . really wanted to make revolution at the beginning, but he became a renegade afterwards."

According to this logic, a renegade who once "represented the proletariat" only "became a renegade afterwards," so he naturally has both "merits" and "faults" and therefore is a forgivable man whose "merits offset his faults" or he even is a "hero" who has more merits than faults. Mao says, "In class society everyone lives as a member of a particular class, and every kind of thinking, without exception, is stamped with the brands of a class." In the eyes of the proletariat, renegades never have been true revolutionaries, but worms and opportunists who sneaked into the revolutionary ranks.

Falling at the enemy's feet and betraying the revolution, one's comrades and brothers, and own soul, all to save one's own life, these are crimes that can never be forgiven. Yet a renegade takes a stand and tries to sell his betrayal of the masses as being justified. He espouses his acts as a philosophy of survival. In his eyes, oneself is everything and one's life is EVERYTHING. The Party's interests, revolutionary principles and national dignity could all be sold provided "his own life and health could be protected."

Renegades fail to understand that "wherever there is struggle there is sacrifice and when we die for the people it is a worthy death." They need only to check out historical revolutions, to understand that thousands of revolutionary martyrs who laid down their lives for the interests of the people were fighters that would have rather lost their lives and shed their blood than loose their revolutionary integrity.

Beginning Friday (March 21) at 6 p.m., a demonstration will be held in solidarity with striking workers at the Chevron Chemical Company in Richmond. Chevron Chemical is a "wholly owned subsidiary" of Standard Oil, and part of the same giant complex as the Richmond refinery. The solidarity demonstration is being held in memory of Richard Jones, an oil worker who was murdered by Standard Oil during the 8 week strike against the refinery. On January 5, while picketing a standard Oil Bulk Station near Martinez, Jones was run over by a Standard Oil tanker, waved on by a Supervisor who saw Jones fall under the truck, not ordered the driver to go ahead anyway. On February 20, Jones died.

The workers at the Standard Oil refinery have since won their strike, but their union brothers at the Chevron Chemical plants are still out on strike. The company -- Standard Oil, negotiating through its puppet corporation, Chevron Chemical -- is trying to force the Chevron workers to go back to work without the union shop agreement they had for 20 years. Without this union shop the company can divide the workers and reduce them to serfs at the complete mercy of the modern-day plantation owners wherein the giant imperialist monopoly like Standard Oil.

Standard Oil, with its billions in bosses, is one of the most vicious instruments of the empire of U.S. imperialism that extends its racist oppression and exploitation throughout the world. Standard is controlled by the Rockefeller family -- which rules a vast financial empire that concentrates its super-exploitation in Africa, South Africa in particular.

The Rockefellers use their biggest bank, Chase-Michigan, to manipulate the economy and the politics of the racist dictatorship of South Africa, where black workers in the Standard Oil plants and other large companies controlled by Rockefeller money are forced to work like slaves for less than a dollar a day. The gold, oil, copper and other valuable resources of Africa, are stolen by the Rockefellers, and their imperialist henchmen, from under the feet of the oppressed people who are forced to live at near-starvation levels.

Standard Oil also steals oil from the Middle East, South America, Indonesia and South Vietnam. The Rockefellers and their cronies have been responsible for the criminal war of aggression and genocide against the people of Vietnam, in Indonesia, after President Sukarno threatened to nationalize some of Standard's stolen oil, Standard simply got the head of the CIA, John McCone (who then owned about one million dollars stock in Standard) to work with right-wing Generals to overthrow Sukarno and give Standard back the Indonesian people's oil. This was in October 1965. Since then, the Fascist generals who ousted Sukarno in collaboration with the CIA, have executed over one half million Indonesian peasants, workers, students and Communist revolutionaries. And these military puppets have dutifully returned the oil to Standard -- plus some new oil fields for exploitation. John McCone retired from the CIA, and was made a member of the Board of Directors of Standard Oil.

In this country itself Standard is a vicious enemy of both third world peoples and the masses of working people. Standard and its

shame! Chevron Chemical not only make chemical defoliants used in Vietnam to wipe out the crops and lives of hundreds of thousands of poor farmers. They manufacture pesticides that are poisoning thousands of farm workers in this country -- who make miserable wages working in the fields owned by the Bank of America (whose President, Rudolf Peterson, is on Standard's Board of Directors). And Standard has given black workers in this country the South African treatment. Until very recently Standard hired almost no black people (except for the dirtiest, lowest-paying jobs); and then, in response to the revolutionary pressure of the masses of black people, Standard tried to bring in black workers to do the same work white guys were doing -- for lower wages than the white guys get! But the union fought this and Standard has been forced to up the number of black workers to about 15 percent and give them a shot at some of the better-paying jobs -- although many blacks are still trapped in the lousy jobs.

The brutality of Standard's bosses has not been reserved only for third world victims. In this present strike Standard has used both cops and company goons to harass and brutalize picketers, white as well as black. And as they showed by killing Richard Jones, Standard's bigshots are willing to go as far as murder to break the back of the workers and their union.

The beatings, gassings and arrests by the pigs has forced the white workers -- many of whom thought the police were their friends -- to go through a lot of changes. Now that they have seen for themselves that the pigs are not there to protect and serve the people, but to force the people to submit to the will of the evicting business, many of the oil workers can understand the real issues of the black and third world liberation movements. The oil workers voted to support the Third World strike at S.F. State -- because they had felt the brutality of the pigs themselves and because students from S.F. State, including third world students, came out to join the oil workers' picket line and break down much of the last remaining resistance between students, piggy and white society.

This is not to say that there is no racism left in the oil workers -- or white society in general. Nor that experience does not drive white working class guys you to want to support the black and third world liberators movements. And this can best be done through direct contact and principled, uncompromising confrontation with the racism implanted in these workers by their bosses.

The solidarity demonstration this weekend will be a good chance to broaden the contact between the Chevron workers still on strike -- including a number of black workers -- and people from the black and third world communities. This kind of solidarity, despite all its difficulties, is exactly what Rockefeller and the other rich tycoons in the racist ruling class of this country fear most. But, whether you make the solidarity demonstration Friday and Saturday, please do not buy any products sold under the signs of Standard and Chevron -- including Ortho products. By refusing to buy their blood-soaked products, you will strike a small, but direct blow against U.S. imperialism.

BLACK MOTHER'S SON BILLY CLUBBED

The information was given to us by John Brigg's son of Mrs. Buckner, the sister beaten up at Kegar after a basketball game. His lawyer, Hiram Smith, wouldn't talk to anyone about it but he gave us a few details of what happened. John Brigg's son was approached by a pig and pushed in the back. He turned around to tell the pig he would keep moving, and the pig pushed him again, and he turned around again. The pig hit him in the face, in the stomach, and across the eye with a billy club. At this time someone called his mother. His mother came on the set. She went to his aid, and they started beating her. The badge number of the pig who beat the brother was number 1212 a white pig of the Tic-Squad. This brother stated that the judge came down or called Park Station at about 12 Midnight. Brothers and Sisters were being released from prison by the judge with no charges. At the time Mrs. Buckner was being beat her son was handcuffed on the ground. The brother was charged with disturbing the peace, and interfering with police and resisting arrest. His mother was charged with assault and battery. Her bail was \$3,000.00.

While the brother was being held at Park Police Station he heard people being beaten in the back of the station, screams came from there while the beating went on.

After the game, Black Brothers swiftly crossed the gym and began to fight with the hooligans from the opposing side. This battle lasted, at the most, three minutes, before the pig broke it up.

As far as the brothers and sisters were concerned, it was all over, and everybody just ready to go home until the pigs brought out their beat bags and began to beat up black people trying to get home. Brothers, she was trying to protect sisters, got the shit beaten out of them by the pigs. The pigs dragged them off into the street for a display. Most of the brothers, were just fine though, they moved out of the way while the pigs were hitting sisters.

The pigs stood in front of the 7 Height bar so the people couldn't get through. The pigs used famous quotes such as, "If you want to go home, get through us", and, "Get your nigger kickers out", and, "Black motherfucker", and, "Piss off nigger, get out of my way".

One incident was when a brother was hit in the mouth with a riot stick. From there he called his mother. When his mother arrived, she was arrested and her arm twisted.

Pigs also beat black people going up Waller Street trying to get home. They also tried to run over several black people with their cars.

My name is Antioch Wadley and I go to Woodrow Wilson High School and I am in the Jew 12 and on Monday I went to the game and I just bought some new clothes, my boyfriend gave me some money, and during the game I saw him. After the game one of my girlfriends was arguing with a policeman, so I grabbed her and told her to come on, don't argue with him, so one of them grabbed me and tore my blouse and I have it on right now he ripped it and I got mad and I went hysterical and I just started chasing the policeman out, so I had a battle with one of them and three officers helped jump on me, the other big guy was they took me to General Hospital, and they gave me three sedative shots and my hand's were tied. They handcuffed me to the bed, my arms and my feet. It all started again so they took me to St. Mary's Hospital in the psych ward without my mother's consent or anyone's. And another thing, about 2 weeks ago I thought I was pregnant I went to the doctor and checked and he said my wounds were open but it is possible that I might be and he gave me some medicine to slow my period down as a result of my being hit in my stomach at the game. I am bleeding again and I don't know if I am hemorrhaging again and I would like to see the San Francisco Police for this.

I would like to report about the medication that the hospital gave me without my parent's consent. My age is seventeen and I was born in Oakland, California, 8-13-64. I will be 18 on August 27 and I was not advised of my constitutional rights.

I had \$6.00 with me when I went to the hospital and \$4.00 that my boyfriend sent to me in the hospital. Yesterday on the 5th I was released from St. Mary's psych ward and they only gave me \$1.00, REPORT BY CM

THE POWER OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

"The Communists fight for the attainment of the immediate aims, for the enforcement of the monetary interests of the working class; but in the movement of the present, they also represent and take care of the future of that movement." - Marx, Engels in the COMMUNIST MANIFESTO.

In my last article I pointed out that there has never been an organization in the U.S., to my knowledge, including the one founded on the theory of the above decree, that has been able to carry forth this dual-principled program. Each one has either lost sight of its revolutionary perspective and fallen into the pit of reformism or has been verbally revolutionary only, not caring to deal with the daily demands of the people, thereby isolating themselves from the people.

I believe that the Panthers can fulfill that double role; indeed, they have proved it in several ways since their inception a scant 3 years ago. When Huey and Bobby carried on their armed patrols; when the Panthers marched into the State Legislature, armed, they showed the people not only their willingness to practice their theory, but they shot the old divine-right-of-government theory full of holes. (No pun intended. But there it is.) The government was vulnerable; it could be beaten. Now, we all know it. They proved also, the legality of carrying weapons: a lesson not only for immediate self-defense, but opening the door or preparation for the final confrontation. Self-defense is no longer a vague hope to be hidden in closets and discussed in hushed tones. It has become, with Huey's tutoring, a reality, a visible pressure, a practice. A practice that is becoming increasingly wide-spread; there are now armed patrols in several cities across the country and people are advocating it now who said nary a word before, let alone, "Arm yourselves!"

When the Panthers knocked on doors talking to people about the political candidates of Huey, Bobby, Eldridge and Kathleen, they

were carrying out the first, the most important organizing function: talk with the people, know the people and their needs and discuss what action is necessary to satisfy those of the elected struggle, they referred constantly - and applied it to the Panther Program. The Panther Program is the demands of the people; a written expression of both the immediate and long-range needs while recognizing, as stated clearly in Point #7 that all of these cannot be satisfied under the present system of economic exploitation, if full employment cannot be guaranteed and it most definitely cannot if super profits are to be maintained, then the people must take over the basic means of production and run the businesses and industries by themselves, for themselves. Self-determination for the Black Celley will never be given by the colonial rulers; it will have to be taken. Here is a perfect example of fulfilling the 2 basic components - reform and revolution: We want freedom. There are lots of daily freedoms that are partially attainable under capitalism: more jobs, better housing, taxation, more representation, even community control of police and schools are possibilities; freedoms that will cost the profit-mongers less to give than to withhold - with the proper threats and perhaps a little PHYSICAL pressure. But the ultimate freedom, self-determination is unthinkable without revolt.

The breakfast program is another example of meeting immediate needs within a revolutionary perspective. It is, of course, a humanitarian thing to do; no child should be hungry, ever. But it is the Panthers, a political party with revolutionary orientation that has initiated and is carrying through the program. Why should they bother with hungry kids? Because kids are the only insurance we have of a new and different tomorrow and superprofits too high to pay. Educational skills are important; reading and writing are good things to know and when that time comes, as it inevitably will, when they learn that what they are



reading and writing is irrelevant, they will have the tools with which to fight for something meaningful, for control of the schools, of who teaches and what is taught; for the implementation of Point #5.

Finally, to answer the other question posed at the beginning of this 2-part article, how have the people accepted the Panther program? I think this is most clearly demonstrated by 3 living examples. First, to be expected, is the program of the Black Student Union. It is simply the Panther platform applied to the specific needs of the school population. Apparently, the BPP program applies not only to the people in the community, but also to young people entrenched in the phony, lying educational system drag society offers.

Secondly, the program of the Brown Berets, written to meet the needs of the Spanish-speaking community is similar in many ways to the Panther program. Let's look at some of their demands. Point #4: "We demand that the true history of the Mexican-American be taught in all schools in the Southwest States." #5 demands that "all police officers in Mexican-American communities must live in the community and speak Spanish." (Community control of police). #6: "We demand that all Mexican-Americans be tried by juries consisting of only Mexican-Americans." (A peer jury as demanded in BPP Point #5) #10: "We demand the right to keep and bear arms to defend our communities against racist police, as guar-

anteed under the Second Amendment of the U.S. Constitution." Obviously, the original 10-point BPP platform, written for the Black community, expresses also the demands of other Third World peoples. The Brown Beret motto, incidentally, is TO SERVE - TO OBSERVE - TO PROTECT, first practiced in the south by Huey P. Newton, in 1966.

But what of the Mothercountry poor, exploited by the same profit-hungry capitalists? What of the white working class - that essential ally for a revolutionary victory? Late class community of Cleveland, Ohio. The first section under the heading WHAT WE WANT has 10-points, among which are:

2) We want freedom from robbery and control by the corporations. (Refer to Point #2, BPP platform)

3) We want power for the working people to control the basic means of production such as industry and agriculture. (Point #2, BPP platform)

4) We want an education for our people that exposes the true nature of this corrupt, racist, rich man's society. We want an education that teaches us the true history of the people. (Point #5, BPP platform)

5) We want compensation for poor people and the victims of racism. (Point #3, BPP Platform)

6) We want an immediate end to police brutality and murder of black, white and brown working people. We want the courts and prison system to protect the working people rather than the property of the rich. (Point #7, BPP platform)

9) We want an end to the Draft. We want a working people's militia formed to defend our country, based on the Constitutional right to bear arms. (Point #6, BPP)

10) As a first step, we want a truce signed between black, white and brown working people, in the community and on the job, as we recognize that fighting among ourselves only serves the rich. (I include this last point, not because of similarity, but rather because it demands a necessity - and holds a beautiful promise.)

The second section entitled WHAT WE BELIEVE, explains the first 10 points and at the beginning of the 10th point, there is a quote: "When in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bonds . . ."

The program is based entirely on the class structure of this society and the need for a black-white working class coalition, which is correct for a white community as the exploitation of white workers is purely a class factor,

but it is obviously patterned the BPP Platform.

It is clear that the Panthers are implementing their program around the fulfillment of the immediate needs of the Black Community - and plan to continue with programs like free health clinics, liberation schools to fill the educational vacuum created by the public schools and community control of various aspects of life. The program is being tested - and it's working. And it is obvious from the above that the program is a universal one, applicable to all working people.

Whatever the Panthers have done has been done in a revolutionary manner; in all areas of struggle they have maintained and revitalized their understanding of the necessity to qualitatively alter this decaying, most corrupt of all economic systems.

What is the probability of the BPP falling into the reformist trap or being left out on the purely revolutionary bush? I cannot envision the present leadership leading us into the boiling pot of reformism. Reformism is a result of either the inability or unwillingness to recognize the primary enemy - Monopoly Capitalism or to compromise that knowledge. The Panthers KNOW the enemy and with their total commitment to the people, cannot compromise at this time. The danger lies in the possibility of the struggle going on indefinitely with the present leadership forced into inactivity by imprisonment or physical harm (Reason #1 why they must be protected) and the younger, not yet politically mature being sucked into the system via the Poverty Program or some other lying promises. Neither can I foresee an isolationist revolutionary demise of the Party - for 3 reasons:

a) The community activities being carried on today are an evident attempt to meet the immediate demands of the Black community successfully - judging from the breakfast program; educationally, in terms of the political campaigns.

b) There is an enormous revolutionary potential within the Black working class which will intensify, thereby bringing the people ever closer to the Party and c) the Panthers, having come from the poor, identify with the people more than with decadent theory. Isolation is the result of intellectual rather than emotional involvement.

That is why I'm convinced that the Black Panther Party has the program that will not only heal the wounds and fractures in the Celley, but will ultimately lead us all out of the horror that is capitalism into the promise that is socialism.

HUEY AND RIO GRANDE COLLEGE

Why should students on this campus be concerned with Huey P. Newton, Defense Minister of the Black Panther Party -- an Afro-American now serving 2-15 years in one of California's pig pens?



PEOPLE'S TRIBUNAL

LOS ANGELES, Calif. (LNS)— More than 300 people gathered at a recreation center in the black community of Los Angeles March 1 where the Black Alternative, a new black community group here, held a community tribunal against various leaders of the Black Congress.

The Black Alternative is a loose coalition of various black militant groups in L.A., ranging from the Black Panther Party to SNCC. The Black Alternative was organized about two months ago under the leadership of Margaret Wright, a well-known leader in the black community here.

The black community tribunal charged the leaders of the Black Congress (which itself is a supposed umbrella organization claiming membership of some 50 black "grass roots" organizations in L.A.) with committing "crimes against the interests of the black community."

Specifically, the charges were that the leaders'怠慢——Walt Bremond, Rev. Karenga, and Keyes Hayes——were "derelict

in their duty to the black community, showed cowardice in the face of the enemy, refused to be held accountable for the money which they received and finally created turmoil and hysteria in the black community which led directly to the deaths of John Huggins and "Bunchy" Carter of the Black Panther Party."

Some 30 black community leaders were "summoned" by the tribunal to testify against Bremond, Karenga and Hayes. Various members of the five-man tribunal board presented evidence themselves to show that Bremond, as director of the Black Congress, had collected within a five-month period, more than \$50,000, which was unaccounted for later. It was no accident, the tribunal hinted, that after this financial loss was discovered, Bremond held a press conference and then resigned as director of the Black Congress.

Tal Hayes, of the Afro-American Association, detailed further other charges against Bremond and the Black Congress. According to Hayes, the Black Congress, before

its collapse, did not represent five groups, let alone the 50 it claimed to represent. According to him, Bremond and Karenga were the Black Congress.

Hayes also said that within a period of five months the Black Congress staff had received over \$15,000 in salaries. Hayes also charged that Bremond himself is solely interested in gaining personal power and wealth. And as a consequence, Hayes held that Bremond was directly responsible for creating the bitter climate that led to the assassinations of Higgins and Carter at UCLA. (Also, the US organization, led by Karenga, is a principal in the Black Congress, US was deeply implicated in the murders of the two Panthers.)

After Hayes finished, Margaret Wright dealt with the charge that the Black Congress "showed cowardice in the face of the enemy." Mrs. Wright explained that the Black Congress has never stood up forcefully for the rights of black people in Los Angeles.

She pointed out that the Black

Congress never offered to help the Black Student Unions in their struggles against the racist administrations on Southern California college or high school campuses.

She noted that this was particularly noticeable during the recent black student action at San Fernando Valley State College. She further revealed that the Black Congress, after the assassination of Dr. King, attempted to collaborate with the cops to keep L.A. "cool," rather than trying to protect black people against the racist attacks of the police.

Brother Creek, head of SNCC in L.A., was the last to testify. He told of how the Black Congress received grants from both the Ford and the Rockefeller Foundations. Creek described how the Black Congress took Rockefeller money and opened up a string of Standard gas stations throughout the black community. Thus the Black Congress, according to him, was supporting intensly on Nixon's "black capitalism" plan.

Creek also said that the Black

Congress gave tacit support to the entire slate of Democratic candidates during the 1968 presidential election. Creek finally pointed out that Bremond, in addition to being director of the Black Congress, also maintained positions on the "Urban Coalition," and the "Brotherhood Crusade," of which Bremond is president; he intends to raise \$3 million nationally for programs in the black community. It was noted that the managing board of the "Brotherhood Crusade," with the exception of Karenga, Bremond and some other black people, is composed largely of white business men.

The tribunal closed by asking for a vote on the guilt or innocence of the selected leaders. The vote from the audience was unanimous. Bremond, in particular, along with Karenga and Hayes, was convicted. Although it was stipulated beforehand that there would be no punishment, the black community, it was hoped, would make the final decision on what would ultimately be done with the three.



If you had Black Panthers marching citizens arrests against op-



Once Again - Police Brutality

The strategy employed here is "to unite to fight a common enemy." The Garment Contractors are pigs. They exploit the labor of 4,800 workers who slave in their sweatshops for seventy cents an hour. This is analogous to Mao's Red Army uniting with Chiang Kai-Shek's forces to oust Japanese Imperialists.

On Friday, March 15, the Red Guards attended a meeting with community elders from the Garment Contractors to discuss how to keep the white racist unions out of Chinatown, i.e., unions such as the Teamsters who are organizing the pigs and who use their power to brutalize Board of Education meetings over dead issues like busting.

The Red Guard attended as security in case union goons were sent to break up the meeting at Powell and Pacific Streets. While the elders were discussing the formation of their own union in order to force the white racist unions away from Chinatown, work reached the meeting that pigs were harassing our security force posted outside. Apparently, a pig gave chase to a brother whom he thought was carrying a rifle (our right to bear arms is protected by the Second Amendment of the Constitution), but the brother got away. The pig then called for reinforcements from a gas station across the street, and re-crossed the street to tell the crowd, which was composed of Red Guards from the meeting, to disperse. The pig was met with verbal abuse when his reinforcements came. This is the pig, David Utter, then told the Red Guard to "get off the street." The Guards told the pig that this was our community and that HE should get off OUR street. Besides, where do they expect street people to go, if we can't be on the streets?

By this time, there were three squad cars (12 pigs), three undercover cars (5 pigs), and one paddy wagon (7 pigs) on the scene. The Guard decided to return to the meeting at this time, but as they were entering the meeting hall, the elders had already dispersed the meeting and were in the process of leaving. After talking with the elders, the pigs started to retreat. As the last squad car was leaving, it was hit by two quarter-sized rock-pop bottles which did no damage to either car nor its occupants. The pigs then got out of the car, clubs in hand, approached the crowd of Guards and elders and started to swing at a brother - not the one who threw the bottle. One pig gave chase to the brother and was tripped flat on his face. By this time, reinforcements had arrived again. They started to beat the crowd, hitting six people, injuring one sister, swinging at women including one pregnant sister, and attacking a camera man as they were dispersing. None of the elders were hit although they were swinging at by the pigs.

At this time, one pig started to swing his club at our Minister of Culture, Wing Quan. Wing grabbed the club and the pig snickered, "Get out of here." Wing started to leave but three other pigs approached him from behind and ordered him to "stop." All four of the pigs then proceeded to club him viciously on the head until he fell to the ground. He was then arrested on charges of assault with a deadly weapon (a felony), resisting arrest and possession of a deadly weapon (a pocket knife which never left his pocket). He was held on \$3,000 bail - bond was posted by the Garment Contractors. Wing's injuries were minor scalp lacerations. He was released that same night.

The question which arises is: Were the pigs there by accident? Answer: Not. The Red Guard and the elders were meeting to try to keep the Teamsters out of Chinatown at the same time that Teamsters are organizing a Pellegrino's Union. The pigs were sent to break up the meeting so that the pig unions could exploit our workers for no benefits. The Red Guard says that they will protect their people from exploitation and brutality of this white racist pig power structure by any means necessary. OFF THE PIGS!

There will be a demonstration protesting police brutality of our people on Saturday, March 22, 1969 at Fortieth Street (corner of Kearny and Washington Street, San Francisco) at 1:00 PM. POWER TO THE PEOPLE!!!

POLITICAL PROGRAM

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our people, the Yellow Community.

We believe that Yellow people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our Yellow community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

3. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

4. We want all Yellow men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Yellow people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like Yellow people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

5. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY AND MURDER OF Yellow People.

We believe we can end police brutality in our Yellow community by organizing Yellow self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our Yellow community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We, therefore, believe that all Yellow people should arm themselves for self defense.

6. We want freedom for all Yellow men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all Yellow people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

7. We want all yellow people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peers.

group or people from their Yellow communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that Yellow people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the Yellow community from which the Yellow defendant comes. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man of the Yellow community."

8. We want adequate and free medical facilities available for the people in the Yellow community.

We know that Chinatown has the highest density area next to Manhattan. It also has the highest TB and sickness rate in the nation.

9. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white american businessmen will not give full employment, then, the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living. There are thousands of immigrants coming into Chinatown every year and it is almost impossible for them to find gainful employment.

10. We demand that the United States government recognize the People's Republic of China.

We believe that MAO TSE-TUNG is the true leader of the Chinese people; not CHIANG KAI SHEK. The government of the United States is now preparing for war against the Chinese People's Republic and against the Chinese people. The racist government of the United States has proven that it will put only peoples of color in concentration camps. American Indians were placed in concentration camps, Japanese were placed in concentration camps; therefore, it is logical that the next people that will be going are the Chinese people; because the United States is gearing its war time industrial complex for war against China.

China upholds revolutionary tradition, leads struggles of oppressed peoples; Soviet revisionists will not to U.S. imperialism.

On March 2, Soviet troops carried out a provocative attack on Chinese border guards at Che-pai-lan. The Chinese repelled the attack, wounding many of the invading troops. In a radio broadcast the Chinese warned the ruling clique of the Soviet Union: "Should you dare to continue to instigate armed provocation, you will be resolutely, completely, cleanly and totally destroyed once and for all whether you come by land, by air or by sea and no matter how many of you come or with whom you come." The last part of the warning clearly refers to the conspiracy between the Soviet revisionists and the U.S. imperialists to harass, provoke, and attack the Chinese People's Republic.

The Chinese People's Republic guided by Chairman Mao-tse-tung and the Chinese Communist Party, is the leading force in the worldwide revolutionary struggle of oppressed nations and laboring masses against the imperialist ruling classes, headed by the U.S. imperialists, together with their bootlicking collaborators, the Soviet revisionists. The Chinese revolution is a thorn in the side of the revisionists -- who have betrayed the Soviet working people by taking the country back to capitalism and betrayed the oppressed peoples of the world by selling out to the Rockefellers, the Fords, the DuPonts and the rest of the criminal gang that makes up the U.S. imperialist ruling class.

How did the Soviet Union, which was once a socialist country and an inspiration to millions of down-trodden people throughout the world, come to be the accomplices of the U.S. imperialists? The Soviet Union was not always ruled by a handful of revisionist capitalists in workers clothing. Led by Lenin from 1917 to 1924, and by Stalin from 1924 to 1953, the Soviet Union was ITSELF hated bitterly, surrounded and bounded by the imperialists.

The Russian Revolution, in October, 1917 overthrew the Russian capitalists and created the first state ruled by the working class, in alliance with the poor peasants. Under the leadership of Lenin and Stalin, the Soviet red army turned back invasions by 14 imperialist countries, including the U.S. The Soviet revolution established self-

determination and autonomy for all the oppressed nationalities of old Tsarist Russia; overcome the treachery and defeatism of opportunists like Trotsky and Bukharin and built a mighty socialist state.

The success of the Soviet revolution was a great inspiration not only to the working people of the advanced capitalist countries -- including the U.S. -- but to the oppressed, colored peoples of the East. Marxism-Leninism, the theories of Marx and Lenin, developed through years of revolutionary struggle, was the tool the Chinese people utilized in making their own revolution. With the political, moral and material help of the Communist International, led by the Soviet Union, the Chinese workers and peasants, the great majority of the people, carried on a long struggle, through many setbacks, until the final victory of their revolutionary war, and the establishment of the Chinese People's Republic in 1949. This entire struggle of the Chinese people, covering more than 20 years, was led by the Chinese Communist Party, headed by Chairman Mao, whose thought represents Marxism-Leninism at its highest stage in the present period. This explains the importance of the little red book of "Quotations of Mao-tse-tung", many of which are reprinted in the Black Panther.

During their struggle to overthrow the landlords and the big capitalists, and drive their imperialist masters out of China, the Chinese people's closest ally was the Soviet Union, led by Stalin. As Mao himself wrote in December, 1959: "Stalin is the true friend of the cause of liberation of the Chinese people. No attempt to sow dissension, no lies and calumnies can affect the Chinese people's whole-hearted love and respect for Stalin and our genuine friendship for the Soviet Union."

But soon after Stalin died in 1953, the leadership of the Soviet Communist Party and government was usurped by a handful of traitors -- revisionists like the notorious Liu Shao Chi, who today in China opposes the revolutionary leadership of Mao-tse-tung. While pretending to be communists, Khrushchev and his cronies began to reverse the Russian revolution, to convert the Russian Communist Party from the vanguard of the working people to the apparatus of a new privileged elite of capital-

ist exploiters. To do this, against the revolutionary will of the Soviet people, they cooperated with their buddies in the U.S., the imperialist ruling class. From supporter of worldwide liberatory movements, the Soviet government was turned into the concealed and even open opponent of wars of national liberation. The Soviet traitors developed the phony line that a single war of national liberation might be the spark that would set off a world war. But they were really concerned with preserving their privileged position and not getting their imperialist bosses mad at them. They wheeled and dealt with the imperialists, inside and outside the United Nations, to divide the world into Russian and American spheres of influence.

In opposition to the revolutionary struggle the Soviet revisionists demanded pacifism on the part of the oppressed and exploited people who were directly under the boot of the imperialists. These revisionists put forward the phony slogan of the "three peacefuls": "Peaceful transition" from capitalism to socialism; "peaceful coexistence" between the oppressed peoples and their oppressors; and "peaceful cooperation" between themselves and their imperialist crime partners.

The record of the crimes of the Soviet revisionists is too long to repeat here. But the following is a brief outline of their worst misdeeds:

July 1959: Without any prior notice, they cancelled hundreds of aid agreements with the Chinese People's Republic and withdrew all Soviet aid, technicians, and blueprints from China -- leaving scores of factories and plants unfinished and causing temporary havoc to China's economy. This was the same thing the U.S. imperialists were doing to the Cuban people, after the victory of the Cuban revolution in 1959.

July 1960: Voted in the U.N. Security Council to send U.S. controlled U.N. troops to the Congo, which led to the overthrow of the popular Congolese government of Patrice Lumumba and maligned the Congo as a hunting ground for the U.S. imperialists and their accomplices.

1959 - 1962: Publicly supported the Indian government, a pawn of U.S. imperialism, in its border provocations against, and direct invasion of, China. The Soviet Union furnished India with air-

planes and other military aid.

1959-1961: Withdraw all aid from the People's Republic of Albania, cut off aid from that heroic European socialist country, and publicly called for a coup against Enver Hoxha, leader of the Albanian Communist Party. (The Soviet revisionists were embarrassed and angered when the Albanian People's Republic, a small East European state, bravely de-

pendent on Soviet aid, said the Albanian people would rather go to grass than turn revisionist).

1963: Signed a pact with the U.S. and Britain to cease all atmospheric nuclear tests and tried to pressure all nations in the world to go along with the scheme to prevent China from developing an atom bomb and keep the monopoly of nuclear weapons in the hands

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of the two so-called "super-powers"; the U.S. and Russia, along with their junior partner, England. Early development of a nuclear bomb requires atmospheric testing. Later development of MORE and DODGER bombs requires only UNDERGROUND testing, which was continued at a heavy pace by both the U.S. and the Soviet Union. The Chinese people declared that they would never be the first to use nuclear weapons, and proposed the destruction of ALL such weapons, but the U.S. imperialists and Soviet revisionists refused and the Chinese had no choice but to develop these weapons, at great cost to themselves, for SELF-DEFENSE. In 1966, the Soviet traitors signed another joint declaration with the U.S. and Britain, designed to keep a monopoly of nuclear weapons in their criminal hands, and threatening reprisal against any other country that tried to develop nuclear weapons. It hardly needs recalling that the U.S. imperialists are the only ones ever to USE these weapons -- which they did twice against the Japanese people in 1945. AFTER the Japanese government had offered to surrender! In 1969 the Soviet revisionists are still wheeling and dealing with the U.S. imperialists -- through the current so-called non-proliferation treaty -- to maltreat both as prime members of the nuclear club.

1966: The Soviet government extended credit to, signed an aid agreement with, and established close diplomatic relations with the fascist dictators of Indonesia, Suharto and Nasution, only a few months after these fascist Generals overthrew the anti-imperialist government of Sukarno; murdered over a half a million Indonesian workers, peasants, students and communists; and turned over the oil fields and other valuable land and resources to the U.S. imperialists, especially Standard Oil.

1968: Carried out naked aggression against the people of Czechoslovakia, in collaboration with their revisionist junior partners in that country the Soviet imperialists are converting Czechoslovakia into an occupied neo-colony within the Soviet imperialist sphere of influence.

1966-67: Collaborated with the U.S. to set up a ring of hostile encirclement around People's China by establishing relationship and agreements with the reactionary ruling classes of Japan, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, and the Philippines. The Soviet renegades have placed strong military forces at all Soviet-Chinese border areas and carried on numerous military and political provocations at these border areas.

1965-69: Met scores of times -- openly and in secret -- with representatives of the U.S. and British imperialists to work out joint strategy for ending the Vietnamese people's war of national liberation against U.S. imperialism, with the U.S. imperialists remaining in South Vietnam. The Vietnamese people, while they have accepted the limited military assistance offered by the Soviet revisionist traitors, have not fallen for the trap laid by these scoundrels in collaboration with their imperialist masters.

1966-68: Jailed, brutalized and repressed numerous demonstrators in Moscow who protested against imperialism and revisionism.

These crimes, and many others, expose the Soviet revisionist rulers for what they are today: Renegades, traitors to Marxism-Leninism, the peoples of the world, and the revolutionary tradition of the Soviet people and working class; Social-Fascists, that is, socialist in name, fascist in fact; Social-Imperialist, that is, socialist in name, imperialist in fact. Next to the U.S. IMPERIALISTS,

working class itself, a true vanguard organization, is the world of Chairman Mao in his statement of April 16, 1965, in support of the black people's struggle: "The black masses and the masses of white working people in the United States have common interests and common objectives to struggle for. Therefore, the Afro-American struggle is winning sympathy and support from increasing numbers of white working people and progressives in the United States. The struggle of the black people in the United States is bound to merge with the American workers' movement, and this will eventually end the criminal rule of the U.S. monopoly capitalist class."

Soviet Revisionism Betrays

At the Second International Conference in Support of the Arab Peoples (January 25-28, 1969) in Cairo, the Soviet revisionists again showed that they are working hand-in-glove with the U.S. imperialists to defeat the armed liberation struggle of the Arab peoples. Though the Soviet revisionists themselves sponsored the so-called support conference, their proposal for a "political settlement" of the Middle East situation is a betrayal of the heroic struggle of the Arab peoples against U.S.-Israeli aggression.

The Soviet revisionists advocated that the Arab peoples adhere to the resolution of the Middle East crisis which was designed by the U.S. imperialists and their Soviet revisionist co-conspirators in the U.N. Security Council in November, 1967. Falling even to acknowledge the armed Palestinian liberation struggle, the Soviet revisionists warned the Arab representatives at the conference that unless they reach a "political settlement" of the situation, developments in the Middle East will "lead to a dangerous aggravation of the explosive tension." Thus the Soviet revisionist clique clearly threatened the Arab peoples to halt their armed liberation struggle against the Israeli aggressors-henchmen of U.S. imperialism.

The heroic Arab peoples were not deceived by the cowardly growling of the Soviet revisionist running dogs-advocates of peaceful coexistence and "political settlements." The delegate to the conference from the Palestine National Liberation Movement (AL-FATAH) clearly denounced the Soviet revisionist-U.S. imperialist conspiracy to defeat the Arab liberation with a "political settlement," he said:

We categorically reject the U.N. Security Council resolution of November 22, 1967, and the subsequent Soviet and American proposals or any form of political settlement, because all such proposals skirt the right of the Palestinians to liberate their country and to restore their homeland.

We will never accept any substitute to the national liberation which we will tenaciously hold on to, regardless of sacrifices and costs.

ALL POWER TO THE ARAB PEOPLE

THE Soviet revisionists are the main enemy of the world's peoples today. They are the gangland bosses of a whole group of phony communist parties that followed the lead of the Soviet revisionists and became tools in the machinery of oppression, run by the imperialists. In the U.S., the so-called "Communist Party" liberates the dirty work of the imperialists by trying to convince the people that one group of slaveholders (such as the Democrats) is better than another (such as the Republicans). In Bolivia, the renegade Maoists betrayed the guerrilla struggle led by Che Guevara and was responsible for Guevara's death. 

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
WEST EUROPE THUNDERS: NIXON GO HOME!

No one had seen U.S. Imperialist Nixon arrive up to his presidential visit after a month in office than he crossed the Atlantic, taking with him a huge force of armed bodyguards, three tank bullet-proof limousines, and got lost in Western Europe. That the American President had to journey here and there visiting allies in Western Europe at a time when inside the United States the struggle of the American people was mounting, the financial and monetary crisis was worsening and strife within the ruling circles was growing more acute makes it still clearer that U.S. imperialism, torn by crises at home and abroad, is in a worse than ever position.

Nixon's 8-day (February 23 to March 20) itinerary took him to Belgium, Britain, West Germany, Italy and France. U.S. officials and press disclosed that the trip was designed to patch up the irreparable split in the imperialist bloc and make it possible for the United States to hold its ground in Western Europe by coining and coaling the West European "allies" which had become increasingly resentful of U.S. control. On the other hand, it was intended to pave the way for the next round of bigger scale global counter-revolutionary deals with the Soviet revisionists. It was generally the belief of the Western press that Nixon's tour of Western Europe was a "prelude" to his "summit meeting" with the Soviet revisionist chief, Brezhnev.

Much as Nixon had done before leaving Washington to work on public opinion to put his visit in a favorable light, it was not bouquets with which the awakening people in Western Europe greeted the "arrival of the greatest person." They welcomed the new U.S. imperialist boss with angry shouts of "Nixon, go home!"

Belgium. Belgium was the first stop in Nixon's tour. Before his arrival in Brussels, several hundred Belgian youths on the afternoon of February 23, waving flags of the South Vietnam National Front for Liberation and shouting "U.S. imperialism get out!" "Get with NATO!" and other slogans, held a rally and demonstration in the heart of the capital to protest the visit. The Belgian authorities hurriedly enclosed off the entire airport area when Nixon arrived in the evening. But more than 300 youths broke through the cordon soon after he got off the plane. Climbing on to airport roofs, they shouted in one voice: "Nixon, go home!"

Britain. Nixon flew via London, the second leg of his "working" trip, on February 24 amid roaring protests by the British people. Several hundred protesters demonstrated in front of the U.S. Embassy in Grosvenor Square. They shouted: "Nixon, go home!" "Yankees, go home!" "Peculiar Nixon!" "Down with U.S. imperialism!" "People's war in Nixon out!"

Banners carried by demonstrators read: "Nixon, go home!" "U.S. imperialism is a paper tiger!" "Down U.S. and Soviet imperialist plot against the people of the world!" "Kosygin, Wilson, Nixon all the same!" "U.S. aggressors, get out of Vietnam!" "Victory to Afro-Asian liberation struggle!"

Many demonstrators held small portraits of Chairman Mao and waved copies of the treasured red book *Quotations From Chairman Mao Tse-tung*. They repeatedly shouted: "Long live Chairman Mao!"

The protests and demonstrations alarmed Nixon. Large numbers of security forces were mobilized by U.S. and British police authorities to protect him. All buildings along the streets travelled by Nixon's car were under close guard by police and secret agents. The entire working staff in his hotel were replaced by detectives. Still, the Wilson government was apprehensive about Nixon's safety. Thus according to the British press, it had a "secret bullet-proof vest" especially made for the American President, just to make him feel a bit more "secure" during his 40-hour visit.

West Germany and West Berlin. Hasteily leaving Britain on February 25, Nixon arrived by air in Bonn, West Germany, the same morning. People in Bonn tattered street walls in the American community with anti-U.S. slogans before his arrival. One read: "Yankees, get out of Vietnam!" Another had the

letter "G" in Nixon's name written as a "communist" U.S. emblem.

Nixon showed up in West Berlin the next day. The demonstrators' hostility passed forth at once on Nixon's arrival there. Encountered by a large police force, he was denounced by a mass of angry demonstrators who threw stones, bags of paint, snowballs, and fire-crackers at the motorcade as he rode through the centre of West Berlin in his bullet-proof limousine brought all the way from the United States. Waving red flags, the demonstrators shouted "U.S. fascists!" They burnt the U.S. flag and Nixon's portrait.

Marchers in the demonstration held high the red book *Quotations From Chairman Mao Tse-tung* and evinced their respect for Chairman Mao with warm dogmas.

Italy. Nixon landed in Rome on February 27. To ensure his "safety," the reactionary Italian authorities declared a ban on all mass demonstrations during Nixon's visit and moved tens of thousands of police and gendarmes from different parts of the country to the capital.

But the Italian people, who have a glorious tradition of struggle, defied the government ban and, undaunted by police suppression, took to the streets to voice their strong protest against the new U.S. imperialist chieftain. While Nixon was holding talks with Italian President Saragat in the presidential palace, about 10,000 people held a big demonstration near by. Among the demonstrators were workers, students and Africans and Arabs residing in Rome. The demonstrators gave vent to their indignation by shouting: "Nixon, assassin!" "Nixon, go home!" "Nixon, you are a paper tiger!" and other slogans and held aloft placards reading "Get Italy out of NATO" and "Unite, carry the struggle everywhere against imperialism till victory!" as

they marched on as the presidential palace.

Many demonstrators expressed their affection for the great leader Chairman Mao. They shouted with warm feeling: "Chairman Mao Tse-tung!" "Long live Chairman Mao Tse-tung!"

France. From Italy Nixon flew to France on February 28 to complete the last leg of his 5-nation West European tour. Shortly before Nixon's arrival in Paris, grew after group of Parisian youths attacked U.S. monopoly capital's business establishments in downtown Paris, smashing many office windows of the Pan-American Airways, the American Express and the Hilton Hotel. Pamphlets protesting his visit were distributed by the demonstrators all along the route as Nixon rode from the airport to the centre of the French capital. Red eyes were hung at Nixon's motorcade. The demonstrating youths, holding aloft placards reading "Hail U.S. fascism!" shouted in unison "Kissin, assassin!" Nixon, the God of Plague, was thoroughly dismasted.

On March 1, tens of thousands of workers and students from universities and lycees, defying the government ban and armed police threats, organized a mammoth demonstration to strongly protest the "visit" by the U.S. imperialist boss, the largest since last year's May-June revolutionary storm. Singing *The Internationale* and shouting "Nixon, assassin," they marched in a long procession through downtown Paris carrying red flags. The demonstrators were in a militant mood, and they burnt a dozen or so U.S. flags and several offices of Nixon to show their hatred for U.S. imperialism, the common enemy of the people all over the world. Slogans denouncing U.S. imperialism appeared in many streets of the capital.

Nixon's predecessors Eisenhower, Kennedy and Johnson, had at one time or another made "inspection tours" of Western Europe in the capacity of "protector" or "super boss" of the Western world. But the pomp and bluster of former days is fast diminishing and the countdown of one administration becomes worse than the other. Today, Nixon's trip is only a ghost of his predecessors' trip. For feels the surging tide of the revolutionary struggles of the people the world over has not only accelerated the decline of U.S. imperialism, but has considerably hastened the disintegration of the whole imperialist bloc with the United States at the head.

SIRHAN -- A REVOLUTIONARY

Recently, Sirhan Sirhan has been able to make statements during his trial. Finally we are able to hear from him the thoughts that led to the revolutionary action he carried out.

On the stand he told about the outrages of being forced out of a comfortable home in Jerusalem in 1947 when the Zionists militarily occupied Palestine. The family fled from West Jerusalem into a partially wrecked 100 year old building in the old walled city.

When he spoke of Jerusalem and his early childhood he recalled frequent bombings in the area of his home; looking for heat around an open fireplace in the heated-out building where seven or eighteen families lived; hunger and severe thirst. People in his neighborhood died of starvation.

Mrs. Sirhan testified, "All our money gone; all our furniture gone; we didn't know where to lay our heads. We didn't have beds, we didn't even have a blanket for my baby . . . we slept on the floor and that was made of tile. It was drafty. It was dark. We used to go

thirsty for many days before we could get a drink of water."

She told of "explosions that blew victims to pieces, young men and women tortured and bloodied." Her son, Sirhan, was three years old then and after he saw one such incident, "he took a blanket and covered his face with it. He stayed in bed for two days. For two weeks he didn't want to take his little brother from near the house." Sirhan had fits of trembling after seeing blood, his Mother said, and shook for two weeks after seeing a neighbor's body against a fence.

"He became fearful of the Zionists?" His Mother was asked.

"Yes," replied Mrs. Sirhan. Even in the face of statements like these, the racist prosecutors tried to show an cross-examination that any anti-Jewish sentiments Sirhan developed were the result of prejudices he drew from others or things he read. As for the atrocities Mrs. Sirhan described, the state suggested that little effort was made to spare Sirhan the knowledge or sight of them.

Testimonies like Sirhan's can-

not be easily dismissed. Seen by the cases full in agencies of the power structure which document atrocities from Vietnam to Palestine, Sirhan Sirhan is a revolutionary. He became one because there was no other logical way to go in the face of the brutal occupation of his homeland.

Why Robert Kennedy instead of Nixon or Ronald Reagan was a fence-sitter on the Middle East situation, making statements of sympathy for the plight of starving people everywhere one day, and the next day appearing with Zionist leaders and openly supporting the Israeli government. When the contradiction was seen by his victim, Sirhan, the reaction was fast and severe. The Nixon and Reaganites are consistent, open-faced, and display it a usual feeling for them. But when a liberal asks for respect from third world people by "helping" and then deceives them by representing enemy interests, the liberal can expect a retaliation.

Issa Nakash, Director of the Palestinian Arab Delegation to the U.N., was brought to Los Angeles

after Sirhan's recent outbursts in the courtroom, he stated that he had been able to convey to Sirhan that he is a "great hero to Pal-

estrians in the Middle East who look on him as a victim of the Zionists."

6 Students Arrested in Bronx As 100 Battle With Pigs

NEW YORK (NS) -- More than 100 protesters gathered March 3 at William H. Taft High School, in the Bronx, to picket the recent suspension of black high school student Ron Dixie.

The picket line grew as students stayed out of school to join the protest. The demonstration drew students from Taft's sister school high schools, as well as parents and SDS people from New York University, Fordham and Columbia.

About 11 a.m., cops charged the picket line, isolated black student leaders and an SDS organizer, and beat them. Two victims were hospitalized.

Nine people were arrested on charges of possession of a deadly weapon, assault with a deadly weapon, resisting arrest, obstruction of government services, harassment and possession of marijuana.

Ron's suspension, which initiated the protest, is the latest in a series of repressive actions taken against Taft students since the end of the United Federation of Teachers strike last November.

At that time, the Taft UFT chairman Robert Robins told him that he would get rid of the Black Student Union leaders no matter what he had to do.

Ron was suspended for allegedly distributing the UNI newspaper in the school. As it really happened, Robins asked Ron for a copy of the paper. Ron refused. Robins insisted, so Ron gave him a paper. Hence, his suspension for distributing literature on school grounds.

Other black leaders have been suspended or other trumped up charges.

After the March 3 protest, parents and students met to discuss further political action. The meeting was interrupted three times by police visitors -- a cop on the beat, the local squad and a public relations officer of the local precinct.

On March 4, parents and students picketed again, this time with no cop reaction. The students issued demands, including the removal of cops from school grounds, reinstatement of suspended students and elimination of suspensions and expulsions altogether. Political activity continued throughout the week.

Despite popular protest against Ron's suspension, the local school voted eight to one against rescinding the suspension.

The Taft student body is about 55 per cent black and Puerto Rican and 45 per cent white working class. While black and white students at Taft have not been exactly close, there have been no actual battles between them like at other New York schools, despite the efforts of the administration to turn the races against each other.

"You should stay out of this," a teacher told a white student participating in the demonstration. "It's a colored problem. You'll only get in trouble because of the militiamen."

At the same time, black students were told that they were being "used" by outside SDS agitators. One cop told an SDS organizer who was passing out leaflets, "Sorry we missed you today. Hope to see you tomorrow."

THE BLACK MAN'S ENEMY

The only proper purpose of a government is to protect a man's rights, which means to protect him from physical violence. A proper government is a force only against those who initiate the use of violence. The only proper functions of a government are: the police to protect you from criminals; the army to protect you from invaders; and the courts, to protect your property and contracts from breach and fraud by others, to settle disputes by rational rules, according to OBJECTIVE and IMPARTIAL law rather than the now prevalent practice of subjective and partial rulings. But a government that initiates the employment of force against minorities who have forced no one, the employment of armed compulsion against unarmed victims, is a systematic internal fascism, designed to annihilate the so-called minority -- YOU, the BLACK MAN, such a government has reversed its only moral purpose and switched from the fictitious role of protector to an open acknowledgement of being the Black Man's deadliest enemy, from the disguise of policemen to the role of criminal, vested with the right to wield violence against victims deprived of the right to self-defense.

This government has substituted for the morality of right and wrong the general rule of conduct which stipulates you (fractals within the power-structure) may inflict whatever you please upon the minority providing your aggression is condoned rather than mentioned by

the masses. Keep the populace ignorant of your true goals, until you are so strong and they so weak, that they have lost the intelligence, incentive, foresight, or strength to construct your final bid of enslavement.

The Black Man's mind is his basic tool of survival. Life is given to him, survival is not. His body is given to him, its substance is not. His mind is given to him, its contents are not. To remain alive he must act, and before he can act he must know the nature and purpose of his action. To remain alive he must THINK FOR HIMSELF, not absorb what is told to him by the media of the system, and substitute their propaganda for reality lived everyday by the Black Man.

Do not help the system take reality, honesty and so-called justice. That falsity is the only force holding off the system's secret fear, the fear and reality of knowing that they are unfit to exist; expose falsity and help the truth destroy them. Your consent is their ONLY grasp on life. WILL YOU GIVE THEM THIS LIFE?????

Check out the organizations that are moving to help all people survive. We're concerned about peace for all mankind. If an organization is not moving toward this goal because it's an integral part of the political system, like the Supreme Court or the United Nations, or the police, if it stands in the way of these ideals, then it has to go into the trash can of history, and we won't mourn its passing.

SANTO DOMINGO, February 20 (PL). — Police killed a student hero during a demonstration held to demand increased funds for the Autonomous University of Santo Domingo.

Several other students were wounded when the police, using clubs and tear-gas bombs, attempted to break up a demonstration of students marching through the streets in the vicinity of the University shouting slogans both against the Government and in support of their demands.

At the same time, professors and administrative personnel of the University united in a common front in the fight for increased funds for education.

U.S. MISSIONARY ENSLAVES BRAZILIAN INDIANS

RIO DE JANEIRO, February 23 (PL). — A Baptist missionary from the United States has held a group of Indians enslaved in the Amazon region of Acre, near the Peruvian border, and has been using them to extract radioactive sand which he then secretly exports.

The above denunciation was made to the National Indian Foundation by a group of Brazilian students who had been in the territory of Acre, encountering inhumane conditions and Indians who spoke only English.

The unusual finding served as the basis

for an investigation into the activities of a strange U.S. missionary, whose name was not given.

The students pointed out that the younger people there did not even know their own local dialect.

The missionary, it would appear, had also introduced contraceptive methods among the Indians, for the students found that there were no children there under four. The Yankee missionary had been in the region exactly four years.

The most critical tests facing Johnson are the war in Vietnam and the Negro revolution at home. The fact that the brains in the Pentagon see fit to send 16 per cent black troops to Vietnam is one indication that there is a structural relationship between these two areas of conflict. And the initial outrageous refusal of the Georgia Legislature to seat representative elect Julian Bond, because he denounced the aggressive U.S. role in Vietnam, shows too, the very intimate relationship between the way human beings are being treated in Vietnam and the treatment they are receiving here in the United States.

We live today in a system that is in the first stages of the protracted process of breaking up on a worldwide basis. The rulers perceive the greatest threat to be the national liberation movements around the world, particularly in Asia, Africa, and Latin America. In order for them to wage wars of suppression against these national liberation movements abroad, they must have peace and stability and unanimity of purpose at home. But at home there is a Trojan Horse, a black Trojan Horse that has become aware of itself and is now struggling to get on its feet. It too, demands liberation.

What is the purpose of the attempt that the rulers are now making on the Trojan Horse? Is it out of a newfound love for the horse, or is it because the rulers need the horse to be quiet, to be still, and not cause the rulers, already with their backs to the wall, any trouble or embarrassment while they force the war in Vietnam? Indeed, the rulers have need of the horse's power on the fields of battle. What the black man in America must keep constantly in mind is that the doctrine of white supremacy, which is a part of the ideology of the world system the power structure is trying to preserve, lets the black man in the greatest portion of the suffering and hate which white supremacy has dished out to the non-white people of the world for hundreds of years. The white-supremacy-oriented white man feels less compunction about massacring "niggers" than he does about massacring any other race of people on the earth. This historically indisputable fact, taken with the present persistent efforts of the United States to sow the Soviet Union into an alliance against China, spells DANGER to all the peoples of the world who have been victims of white supremacy. If this

sabotaging proves successful, if the United States is finally able to make a match with Russia, or if the U.S. can convince or frighten the Soviet Union into reneging on its commitments to international socialist solidarity (about which the Soviets are always trumpeting, while still allowing the imperialist aggressors to daily bomb the Democratic Republic of North Vietnam), and if the U.S. is able to unleash its axious fury and armed might against the rising non-white giant of China, which is the real target of U.S. strategy the world over -- if the U.S. is successful in these areas, then it will be the black man's turn again to face the lynch and burn of the world, and face him alone.

Black Americans are too easily deceived by a few smiles and friendly gestures, by the passing of a few liberal-sounding laws which are left on the books to rot unenforced, and by the mouth-scheming of a President who is a past master of talking out of the thousand sides of his mouth. Such poetry does not guarantee the safe future of the black people in America. The black people must have a guarantee, they must be certain, they must be sure beyond all doubt that the reign of terror is ended and not just suspended, and that the future of their people is secure. And the only way they can ensure this is to gain organizational unity and communication with their brothers and allies around the world, on an international basis. They must have this power. There is no other way. Anything else is a sellout of the future of their people. The world of today was fashioned yesterday. What is leveled here, what is being decided right now, is the shape of power in the world tomorrow.

The American racial problem can no longer be spoken of or solved in isolation. The relationship between the peasants in Vietnam and the slaves of the white man toward black Americans is a direct relationship. Once the white man solves his problem in the East he will then turn his fury again on the black people of America, his longtime purchasing dog. The black people have been tricked again and again, sold out at every turn by misleaders, after the Civil War, America went through a period similar to the one we are now in. The Negro problem received a full hearing. Everybody knew that the black man had been denied justice, no one doubted that it was time for changes and that the black man should be made a first class

citizen, but Reconstruction ended, blacks who had been elevated to high positions were brutally kicked out into the streets and herded along with the masses of blacks into the ghettos and black belts. The lyncher and the burner received virtual license to murder blacks at will. White Americans found a new level on which to cool the blacks out. And with the help of such tools as Booker T. Washington, the doctrine of segregation was clamped firmly onto the backs of the blacks. It has taken a hundred years to struggle up from that level of cool-out to the miserable position that black Americans find themselves in. Time is passing. The historical opportunity which world events now present to black Americans is running out with every tick of the clock.

This is the last act of the show. We are living in a time when the people of the world are making their final bid for full and complete freedom. Never before in history has this condition prevailed. Always before there have been more or less articulate and aware pockets of people, portions of classes, etc., but today's is an era of mass awareness, when the smallest man on the street is in rebellion against the system which has denied him life and which he has come to understand robs him of his dignity and self-respect. Yet he is being told that it will take time to get programs started, to pass legislation, to educate white people into accepting the physically impossible, to move as fast as the black man would like to move. Black men are deadly serious when they say FREEDOM NOW. Even if the white man wanted to eradicate all traces of evil overnight, he would not be able to do it because the economic and political system will not permit it. All talk about going too fast is treasonous in the black man's future.

What the white man must be brought to understand is that the black man in America today is fully aware of his position, and he does not intend to be tricked again into another hundred-year forfeit of freedom. Not for a single moment or for any price will the black man now rising up in America settle for anything less than their full proportionate share and participation in the sovereignty of America. The black man has already come to a realization that to be free it is necessary for him to throw his life -- everything -- on the line, because the oppressors refuse to understand that it is now impossible for them to come up with another trick to squelch the black revolution. The black man can't afford to take a chance. He can't afford to put things off. He must stop the whole now and get his business straight, because if he does not do it now, if he fails to grasp securely the reins of this historic opportunity, there may be no tomorrow for him.

The black man's interest lies in seeing a free and independent Vietnam, a strong Vietnam which is not the puppet of international white supremacy. If the nations of Asia, Latin America, and Africa are strong and free, the black man in America will be safe and secure and free to live in dignity and self-respect. It is a cold fact that while the nations of Africa, Asia, and Latin America were shackled in colonial bondage, the black American was held tightly in the vice of oppression and not permitted to utter a sound of protest or effect. Not when these nations started battling for their freedom. It was then that black Americans were able to seize the initiative; it was then that the white man yielded what little he did -- out of sheer necessity. The only lasting salvation for the black American is to do all he can to see to it that the African, Asian, and Latin American nations are free and independent.

In this regard, black Americans



have a big role to play. They are a black Trojan horse within white America and they number in excess of 25,000,000 strong. That is a lot of strength. But it is a lot of weakness if it is disorganized, and the overriding need is for unity and organization. Unity is on all black lips. Today we stand on the verge of sweeping change in this wretched landscape of a thousand little fragmented and ineffectual groups and organizations unable to work together for the common cause. The need for one organization that will give one voice to the black man's common interest is felt in every bone and fiber of black America.

Yesterday, after firmly repudiating racism and breaking his ties with the Black Muslim organization, the late Malcolm X launched a campaign to transform the American black man's struggle from the narrow plea for "civil rights" to the universal demand for human rights, with the ultimate aim of bringing the United States government to task before the United

government. They must let their voice be heard on these issues. They must let the world know where they stand.

It is no accident that the U.S. government is sending all those black troops to Vietnam. Some people think that Vietnam is to kill off the cream of black youth. But if has another important result. By turning her black troops into the butchers of the Vietnamese people, America is spreading hate against the black race throughout Asia. Even black Africans find it hard not to hate black Americans for being so stupid as to allow themselves to be used to slaughter another people who are fighting to be free. Black Americans are considered to be the world's biggest fools to go to another country to fight for something they don't have for themselves.

It bothers white racists that people around the world love black Americans but find it impossible to give a similar warm affection to white Americans. The white-racist knows that he is the ugly



Nation. This, and the idea of the Organization of Afro-American Unity, was Malcolm's dying legacy to his people. It did not fall on barren ground. Already, black American leaders have met with the ambassadors of Black Africa at a luncheon at UN headquarters. The meaning of this momentous event is lost on no one. The fact that it was the issue of Julian Bond, his denunciation of U.S. aggression in Vietnam, and the action of racist elements in the Georgia legislature which brought the leaders of Black Africa together, that their interests are also threatened by the U.S., was of no concern to Vietnam. This dismantling of racism and racism is destined to bring to fruition the other dream which Malcolm's assassination prevented him from realizing: the Organization of Afro-American Unity, or perhaps another organization under a different name. Black Americans now realize that they must organize for the power to change the foreign and domestic policies of the U.S.

American and he wants the black American to be ugly, too, in the eyes of the world: misery loves company! When the people around the world cry "Yankee, Go Home!" they mean the white man, not the black man who is a recently freed slave. The white man is deliberately trying to make the people of the world turn against black Americans, because he knows that the day is coming when black Americans will need the help and support of their brothers, friends and supporters around the world. If through stupidity or by following hand-picked leaders who are the agents of the power structure, black Americans allow this strategy to succeed against them, then when the time comes and they need this help and support from around the world, it will not be there. All of the international love, respect, and goodwill that black Americans now have around the world will have dried up. They themselves will have buried it in the mud of the rice paddies of Vietnam.



U.S. TROOPS AND VIETNAM

"Fully half" the U.S. troops in Vietnam are "against the war to some extent," the noted Chicago Daily News correspondent George Ann Geyer concluded after covering the war for six months.

"Many of these men say the experience of Vietnam has led them to a deep cynicism and skepticism about many of their country's motives and actions."

These highly significant observations about the attitudes and morals of U.S. soldiers in the war were covered in a five-article series in the Chicago Daily News beginning Jan. 13. The CDN press service is nationally syndicated.

In essence, Miss Geyer found that the same, but "much more heralded revolutions" on the campus, in the ghettos and in American political and social structures" are going on in the Army in Vietnam. "It has an Old Right, a New Left, a large middle ground, some simpleminded idealists and a number of confused officers."

There is a significant antiwar movement among the troops "side by side with the highly professional group which tends to view warfare

as a technical endeavor, is a large and vociferous group that frankly does not believe in the war and goes so with amazing candor."

This group, which includes "many of the best educated of the young officers," in particular questions "the rights and wrongs of the Vietnam war and American involvement in it."

The biggest factor that has turned GIs in Vietnam against the war, according to Miss Geyer, is that blatant corruption of the Saigon regime these soldiers are being asked to defend.

"It is certainly one of the first times in history that soldiers have admired the enemy more than they admire their allies."

Notable was this sentiment even among relatively high-ranking officers. "How can you have land reform when all the landowners are the officials in Saigon?" a lieutenant colonel asked Miss Geyer.

A colonel complained to her: "Every day I go into the office of a Vietnamese major to get a pass for my chauffeur. Every day his aide tells me, 'The major's not here.' I see people going in with papers for him to sign and coming out with them signed."

Another officer was asked "Do

what about the Viet Cong?" He replied, "They're different. They believe in something. They have something to fight for. They believe in equality. They've created a unified society."

Not the sort of brass one runs into in bases around the country. He went even further. Miss Geyer told him, "You sound like you think we're on the wrong side."

"I've sometimes wondered," he answered. "The thing is that I don't think communism is all bad. It's one way organizing life, one way of doing things. What right do we have to tell these people how to live their lives? What right do we have to be here?"

ANPCD (top) Miss Geyer found most Vietnamese are against the U.S. "My area is 95 percent North Vietnamese. You go into the hills. The people won't tell you a thing."

He described "interrogation": "I go out and pick up civilians — any civilians — and we put them in the chopper and bring them back to interrogate. We take all their rice, so they hardly have enough left to eat."

"Here you're in a state of suspended animation. It's a dehumanized life."

Miss Geyer's report actually is not startling. In Vietnam Wash-

ington is using the most advanced weapons of modern warfare in a genocidal assault against a population that continues an irrepressible struggle for freedom. That's pretty hard to swallow — especially when you're staring it in the face day after day.

It is interesting to note that in Miss Geyer's report most of the quotes were from officers — and even some fairly high ranking brass at that. This suggests that enlisted men are a bit judicious in talking to reporters.

Enlisted men have the right to speak their opposition to the war — it is guaranteed in the U.S. Constitution. Soldiers are no different from any other American citizens in this respect.

But in order to ensure their being able to exercise this right they need the organized support of the civilian antiwar movement. The antiwar movement outside the army can mobilize the legal aid, the public support the EMS need in their fight against the war.

Besides the day to day work of organizing this support, it is also important that the antiwar movement inside and outside the Army conduct major mobilizations that will focus national attention on the troop opposition to U.S. war.

It is one thing for brass at a base to try to silence GIs on that base; quite different when they are trying to keep them from participating in a demonstration which is nationally known — and moreover widely supported by the civilian population.

These points were recently emphasized by an antiwar GI, Sherman Strain, who explained them at a GI workshop in Washington, D.C., Jan. 18. Stationed at Ft. Belvoir, Va., Strain has been able to ward off victimization for his antiwar views with the support of the antiwar movement.

Strain pointed out that after the big antiwar march led by 500 GIs at San Francisco, last Oct. 12, there have been only two victimizations. It's "because it's legal and they knew the trouble they're going to get" if they press charges, Strain said.

It is this kind of thinking inside and outside the service that underlines the importance of the national antiwar actions which have been set for seven areas for Easter Sunday, April 6.

SERGEANT Mobutu, the all-powerful ruler of the Kinshasa Republic of the Congo, thanks to the backing of the U.S. Central Intelligence Agency, has obviously succeeded in buttressing his power, during this first round, helped along by the obvious and increasing weaknesses of the Congolese revolutionary movement and the support of those — some of them well-intentioned — who consider Mobutu a temporary solution to the Congolese problem, which has cost so many tens of thousands of lives, beginning long before February 13, 1961, the date of Patrice Lumumba's assassination by troops at the service of the United Nations, with the direct participation of Moise Tshombe and Joseph Mobutu.

Leopoldville has adopted the name of Kinshasa, and Lumumba, martyr of the African Revolution, has been declared a national hero of the Congo by no less a person than Mobutu, one of his murderers. The latter has also established a political party and begun a grass-roots campaign of political activities in neighborhoods, plantations and factories peopled or staffed by the Congolese masses, and it certainly must be admitted that he has succeeded in confusing a considerable segment of the people, abetted by the lack of real, effective, practical and steady opposition on the part of the revolutionary movement.

The period 1964-65 was a time of glorious struggle for the Congolese people. Then the National Council of Liberation sustained three zones of operation, where

thousands of Congolese patriots, organized into guerrilla units, fought against Tshombe's rule. At that time the second zone of operations, the Eastern Front, was commanded by Laurent Kabila, aided by Massengo as Chief of Staff. By the beginning of 1966, however, the Eastern Front had been completely broken up. The offensive launched by Tshombe's troops, backed by South African and Belgian mercenaries under the command of the blood-thirsty Mike Hoars, had not been repelled. And this was not essentially because of their military superiority, but rather because of the vacillations of those who, when they should have been at the heads of their fighting columns, risking their lives for their country's liberation, placidly gave battle from their city headquarters, enjoying the benefits of an urban life entailing no risks, mapping out "strategies," although they were no experts in strategy. Such were Laurent Kabila, whose command post was located in a well-furnished apartment in Kigoma (in the Republic of Tanzania), and Massengo, who is not known to have personally led a single action against the imperialist troops in the East.

There can be no doubt that the patriots on the Eastern Front fought bravely and resolutely at the beginning. Proof of this were the attacks in mid-1965 on the Front de Force Garrison and on the School for Special Anti-Guerrilla Troops, where the guerrillas gave innumerable signs of their fearlessness and where dozens fell, and not only the sons of the Congo itself but of other peoples as well, who there had made a solemn internationalist pledge to defend the principles of Lumumba unto death. However, the scant participation of the leaders in the daily course of the war gave rise to a lack of ideology, of combat discipline — affected adversely by tribal and religious prejudices — of readiness for daily sacrifice and death, in the majority of the combatants. These were even promised a monthly wage, as though they were part of a professional army and not revolutionary combatants fighting not only for their own liberation but also for the liberation of Africa from one of the most loathsome neocolonialisms ever known. An outstanding casualty was the loss of Comrade Mitudidi in an accident on Lake Tanganyika. He was a complete revolutionary, fully aware of the movement's weak points and willing to face up to them in a search for practical solutions.

In the third zone of operations the same weaknesses reappeared, also culminating in the collapse of the guerrilla movement, following Ghemys' and Kanza's unquestionable failure of nerve.

The first zone of operations was the only one to stand up after 1966. Only a few months ago, however, its commander in chief, Pierre Mulele, legendary guerrilla, failing to recall the experience of Lumumba, the martyr, placed his confidence in forces which were not exactly those of the people in arms and naively delivered himself up to Mobutu, influenced perhaps by lack of support, the growing division in the ranks of the Congolese revolutionary movement and the long years of solitary revolutionary struggle he had sustained. In his letter of August 3, 1966, Mulele issued an appeal to conscience for the unity of the Congolese revolutionary movement, stating: "The Revolution is not for the PSA or for the MNC or for any other party which may wish to claim a monopoly on it. It is for the revolutionary cause in particular and the Congolese cause in general — which must unite us." Two years later, however, Mulele was assassinated by Mobutu, who had received a direct order to do so from a high-ranking U.S. official when the ruler was on a stopover in Morocco on his way back to Leopoldville.

Clearly Pierre Mulele, who had dominated the grandeur of his revolutionary stature in returning to Leopoldville, was then abandoning the necessary path, the only one which can first curb and then destroy forever, not only Mobutu but everything his rule of puppets and brass hats represents. The war cannot be waged against the figure of Mobutu. Certain revolutionaries, once more indulging

in "naivety," even tried to make contact with the mercenary forces of Kasanga (which, in 1967, were fighting against Mobutu), failing to understand that even if this government got backing and succeeded in staying in power with the aid of the U.S. Government and the direct participation of the Yankee Green Berets, the Katanga mercenaries also represented imperialism, and that the objective of both the mercenaries and Mobutu was the same — namely, to guarantee the exploitation of the country's vast wealth by imperialism, the true and fundamental enemy of the Congolese people and of humanity in general.

It is impossible to combat or destroy the strongholds of imperialism in the Congo while so-called revolutionaries such as Zénon Matimba — who returned to Leopoldville with Mulele and chose to ignore the fate of the latter — continue to encourage divisionism within the movement itself, splits based on questions of international politics and completely unrelated to the advancement of the Congolese people's liberation struggle, or while there are theoreticians such as Nima, who committed himself to leadership of the revolutionary movement and then, after only three days on the march to lend moral and material support to the combatants of the Front (headed at the time by Mulele), abandoned his men and once more chose the safety of life in a friendly capital. Following the political programs worked out by Botchary and Kasimbura (both of whom have been reported dead on the Eastern Front as a result of internal strife), which are based fundamentally on the organization of a political party to head up the struggle they themselves were unable to wage, will not be conducive to success.

Seeds of hatred and divisionism have been planted, and the fruit they have borne has been only the strengthening of Mobutu's position. And those responsible can be found in the ranks of the revolutionary movement itself.

Today, eight years after the death of Lumumba, there is only one way to defend the principles for which he died in the cause of African liberation.

Placing our faith in Mobutu, abandoning the revolutionaries of the Congo because of internal differences, because of political weaknesses and indecision, will never get us onto the road of the Congolese Revolution.

Certain revolutionary groups, not affiliated with any Congolese party or organization, are prepared to renew and advance the liberation struggle. The CNL, under the leadership of Gaston Soumialot, has once more stated that it is prepared to advance the armed struggle. Thus, most of the leaders of that organization have left Cairo. Moreover, rumors seem to indicate that Kabila has once again taken up the revolutionary struggle, after having lived comfortably for the past two years in various capitals of East Africa. In addition, certain CNL spokesmen have stated that the Eastern Front has held on and that it is making progress in organization.

To those who are prepared, over and above all other considerations, to offer up their lives as a contribution to victory, we wish to stress our readiness to stand side by side with them, and we send them our encouragement and militant support; but we urge the fulfillment of one absolutely necessary condition — namely, that they stand up for, put into practice and prove their conscientious dedication to the revolutionary cause, that the writings and trips to African capitals cease, as well as the expressions of demoralization at the lack of support from those who historically should be lending it, and that they fully promote and will that great invincible force represented by their people. They must become sufficient unto themselves by facing up to these tasks and growing greater in resisting difficulties. The memory of Lumumba is to be defended in direct and determined confrontation with imperialism in the fight unto victory or death.

What We Want What We Believe

1. We want freedom. We want power to determine the destiny of our Black Community.

We believe that black people will not be free until we are able to determine our destiny.

2. We want full employment for our people.

We believe that the federal government is responsible and obligated to give every man employment or a guaranteed income. We believe that if the white American businessmen will not give full employment, then the means of production should be taken from the businessmen and placed in the community so that the people of the community can organize and employ all of its people and give a high standard of living.

3. We want an end to the robbery by the white man of our Black Community.

We believe that this racist government has robbed us and now we are demanding the overdue debt of forty acres and two mules. Forty acres and two mules was promised 100 years ago as restitution for slave labor and mass murder of black people. We will accept the payment in currency which will be distributed to our many communities. The Germans are now aiding the Jews in Israel for the genocide of the Jewish people. The Germans murdered six million Jews. The Americas racist has taken part in the slaughter of over fifty million black people; therefore, we feel that this is a modest demand that we make.

4. We want decent housing, fit for shelter of human beings.

We believe that if the white landlords will not give decent housing to our black community, then the housing and the land should be made into cooperatives so that our community, with government aid, can build and make decent housing for its people.

5. We want education for our people that exposes the true nature of this decadent American society. We want education that teaches us our true history and our role in the present-day society.

We believe in an educational system that will give to our people a knowledge of self. If a man does not have knowledge of himself and his position in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

6. We want all black men to be exempt from military service.

We believe that Black people should not be forced to fight in the military service to defend a racist government that does not protect us. We will not fight and kill other people of color in the world who, like black people, are being victimized by the white racist government of America. We will protect ourselves from the force and violence of the racist police and the racist military, by whatever means necessary.

7. We want an immediate end to POLICE BRUTALITY and MURDER of black people.

We believe we can end police brutality in our black community by organizing black self-defense groups that are dedicated to defending our black community from racist police oppression and brutality. The Second Amendment to the Constitution of the United States gives a right to bear arms. We therefore believe that all black people should arm themselves for self-defense.

8. We want freedom for all black men held in federal, state, county and city prisons and jails.

We believe that all black people should be released from the many jails and prisons because they have not received a fair and impartial trial.

9. We want all black people when brought to trial to be tried in court by a jury of their peer group or people from their black communities, as defined by the Constitution of the United States.

We believe that the courts should follow the United States Constitution so that black people will receive fair trials. The 14th Amendment of the U.S. Constitution gives a man a right to be tried by his peer group. A peer is a person from a similar economic, social, religious, geographical, environmental, historical and racial background. To do this the court will be forced to select a jury from the black community from which the black defendant came. We have been, and are being tried by all-white juries that have no understanding of the "average reasoning man" of the black community.

10. We want land, bread, housing, education, clothing, justice and peace. And as our major political objective, a United Nations-supervised plebiscite to be held throughout the black colony in which only black colonial subjects will be allowed to participate, for the purpose of determining the will of black people as to their national destiny.

When, in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume, among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of nature and nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We hold these truths to be self-evident; that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. That, to secure these rights, governments are instituted among men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed; that, whenever any form of government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the right of the people to alter or to abolish it, and to institute a new government, laying its foundation on such principles, and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their safety and happiness. Prudence, indeed, will dictate that governments long established should not be changed for light and transient causes; and, accordingly, all experience hath shown, that mankind are more disposed to suffer, while evils are sufferable, than to right themselves by abolishing the forms to which they are accustomed. But, when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same object, evince a design to reduce them under absolute despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such government, and to provide new guards for their future security.

RULES OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY**CENTRAL HEADQUARTERS
OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA..**

Every member of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY throughout this country of racist America must abide by these rules as functional members of this party. CENTRAL COMMITTEE members, CENTRAL STAFFS, and LOCAL STAFFS, including all captains subordinate to either national, state, and local leadership of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY will enforce these rules. Length of suspension or other disciplinary action necessary for violation of these rules will depend on national decisions by national, state or state area, and local committees and staffs where said rule or rules of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY WERE VIOLATED.

Every member of the party must know these verbatim by heart. And apply them daily. Each member must report any violation of these rules to their leadership or they are counter-revolutionary and are also subjected to suspension by the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.

THE RULES ARE:

1. No party member can have narcotics or weed in his possession while doing party work.
2. Any party member found shooting narcotics will be expelled from this party.
3. No party member can be DRUNK while doing daily party work.
4. No party member will violate rules relating to office work, general meetings, of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY, and meetings of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY ANYWHERE.
5. No party member will USE, POINT, or FIRE a weapon of any kind unnecessarily or accidentally at anyone.
6. No party member can join any other army force other than the BLACK LIBERATION ARMY.
7. No party member can have a weapon in his possession while DRUNK or loaded off narcotics or weed.
8. No party member will commit any crimes against other party members or BLACK people at all, and cannot steal or take from the people, not even a needle or a piece of thread.
9. When arrested BLACK PANTHER MEMBERS will give only name, address, and will sign nothing. Legal first aid must be understood by all Party members.
10. The Ten Point Program and platform of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must be known and understood by each Party member.
11. Party Communications must be National and Local.
12. The 10-10-10-program should be known by all members and also understood by all members.
13. All Finance officers will operate under the jurisdiction of the Ministry of Finance.
14. Each person will submit a report of daily work.
15. Each Sub-Section Leader, Section Leader, Lieutenant, and Captain must submit Daily reports of work.
16. All Panthers must learn to operate and service weapons correctly.
17. All Leadership personnel who expel a member must submit this information to the Editor of the Newspaper, so that it will be published in the paper and will be known by all chapters and branches.
18. Political Education Classes are mandatory for general membership.
19. Only office personnel assigned to respective offices each day should be there. All others are to sell papers and do Political work out in the community, including Captains, Section Leaders, etc.
20. COMMUNICATIONS — all chapters must submit weekly reports in writing to the National Headquarters.
21. All Branches must implement First Aid and/or Medical Cadres.
22. All Chapters, Branches, and components of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY must submit a monthly Financial Report to the Ministry of Finance, and also the Central Committee.
23. Everyone in a leadership position must read no less than two books per day to keep abreast of the changing political situation.
24. No chapter or branch shall accept money, poverty bonds, money or any other aid from any government agency without contacting the National Headquarters.
25. All chapters must adhere to the policy and the ideology laid down by the CENTRAL COMMITTEE of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY.
26. All Branches must submit weekly reports in writing to their respective Chapters.

**8 POINTS OF
ATTENTION**

- 1) Speak politely.
- 2) Pay fairly for what you buy.
- 3) Return everything you borrow.
- 4) Pay for anything you damage.
- 5) Do not hit or swear at people.
- 6) Do not damage property or crops of the poor oppressed masses.
- 7) Do not take liberties with women.
- 8) If we ever have to take captives do not ill-treat them.

**3 MAIN RULES OF

- 1) Obey orders in all your actions.

SOUL ON ICE?

"IT IS ONLY A MATTER OF TIME UNTIL THE QUESTION OF THE PRISONER'S DEBT TO SOCIETY VERSUS SOCIETY'S DEBT TO THE

PRISONER IS INJECTED FORCEFULLY INTO NATIONAL AND STATE POLITICS, INTO THE CIVIL AND HUMAN RIGHTS STRUGGLE, AND INTO THE CONSCIOUSNESS OF THE BODY POLITIC. IT IS AN EXPLOSIVE ISSUE WHICH GOES TO THE VERY ROOT OF AMERICA'S SYSTEM OF JUSTICE, THE STRUCTURE OF CRIMINAL LAW, THE PREVAILING BELIEFS AND ATTITUDES TOWARD A CONVICTED FELON." (SOUL ON ICE, P.59)

Eldridge Cleaver made the decision to politically exile himself November 27th, on the basis that the Adult Authority made an outlaw decision, and that he has been denied his constitutional right to due process of law.

The revocation of Cleaver's parole was illegal, because no parole violation was committed.

The Adult Authority parole board has tried to maintain that Cleaver violated his parole by having a rifle in his possession, and by associating with individuals of bad reputation. This contention, we will show, is false. The Adult Authority version contradicts the Superior Court order itself.

"... Cleaver's only handling of a firearm (the rifle) was in obedience to a police command. He did not handle a hand gun at all. There was nothing one way or the other to show a conspiracy or a situation calling for the application of the doctrine of aiding and abetting. Hence, nothing supported either the possession of a firearm or the assault charge."

As to the charge of association with individuals of bad reputation, the report indicated that two or three of those named had "police records," but nothing to show whether any had been convicted of anything, or whether Cleaver knew of their arrest record." (Superior Court et. al. 137, 138, 140, 141.)

Parolee Cleaver was denied due process of law by being denied opportunity to present his case.

Why was Cleaver returned to prison as a parole violator if documented evidence to the contrary had been presented in his defense? To answer that question, one must examine the Adult Authority. This board has the right to arbitrarily revoke or suspend parole on any individual. At the same time, the Adult Authority maintains—falsely—that Cleaver has the opportunity to defend himself at a hearing. This is how it works:

"A parolee is served with violation charges, is interviewed, is given a hearing (before the Adult Authority itself, the charging party) at which the parolee may 'plead' to the parole violation charges, and is afforded an opportunity to present his defense."

"At the 'hearing' a parolee is denied the right to counsel, may not have an independent and impartial officer to conduct the hearing and make decision." (Petition for Hearing in the Supreme Court, p. 17)

Not only does the Adult Authority hold secret hearings, but it also refuses to notify persons under its jurisdiction of its procedures, or of its variable definitions of what constitutes a parole violation. This secrecy and vagueness is in direct violation of federal law which requires agencies to publish their procedures "for guidance of the public."

"Petitioner (Cleaver) is immediately and seriously prejudiced by the Adult Authority's unlawful refusal to publish its regulations, since he is to be imprisoned by virtue of an action which the Adult Authority still seeks to garb in this 'veil of secrecy.' (Petition for Hearing in the Supreme Court, p. 12)

Yes, the Adult Authority acted unjustly and illegally. Its decision was an outlaw decision; Cleaver had no chance of obtaining "justice" from these Star Chamber proceedings. Why then wouldn't the U.S. Supreme Court hear Cleaver's case? There are, we believe, three reasons why the case wasn't accepted. The first is that any fair minded court would obviously have released Cleaver, thereby setting a precedent. The second is that thousands of cases of alleged parole violation from all over California and other states would be subject to reversal. Thirdly, the illegal functioning of the Adult Authority would come under attack. The U.S. Supreme Court just couldn't afford to consider the Cleaver case during this turbulent period.

Eldridge Cleaver is a victim of naked, shameless political persecution. As Judge Sherwin puts it:

"... The uncontradicted evidence presented to this court indicated that the petitioner had been a model parolee. The peril to his parole status stemmed from no failure of personal rehabilitation, but from his undue eloquence in pursuing political goals, goals which were offensive to many of

his contemporaries. Not only was there absence of cause for the cancellation of parole, it was the product of a type of pressure unbecoming, to say the least, to the law enforcement paraphernalia of this state."

Cleaver is in political exile because a man of his convictions cannot get justice here. Indeed, if we are to give more than lip service to the concept of freedom and justice we must support him. The work to get him discharged from parole must continue. An intense publicity campaign is necessary now to bring to the public the legal defense and arguments which were carried to the courts with no satisfaction. We must all work together to focus attention on this case. This is not an issue of one man's freedom, but a broad struggle which affirms the right of all of us to speak out politically in this country. If Cleaver is not allowed his freedom, it is just a matter of time until all our freedoms are further reduced. His is not a personal struggle but a political one.

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BLACK PEOPLE: KEEP YOUR GUNS

CALIFORNIA AND FEDERAL GUN LAWS

This article is to serve as a guide for the members of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY and is not to be construed as a substitute for competent legal counsel.

12001 -- A concealable firearm is any firearm having a barrel less than 12 inches in length.

12005 -- Any person caught with a concealable firearm CONCEALED on their person or within any vehicle is guilty of a misdemeanor.

12020 -- No license is required for any citizen 18 years or over to keep a legal weapon in their home or place of business. Some weapons require federal registration.

12027 -- Persons exempt from Section 12005 includes members of any club or organization organized for the purpose of practicing shooting at targets upon established target ranges, whether public or private, while such members are using firearms upon such target ranges, or while going to and from such ranges.

12031 -- Except as provided in subdivision (g), every person who carries a loaded firearm on his person or in a vehicle while in any public place or on any public street in any incorporated city or in any public place or on any public street in a prohibited area of unincorporated territory is guilty of a misdemeanor.

(g) Persons who are using target ranges for the purpose of practice shooting with a firearm, or who are members of shooting clubs while hunting on the premises for such clubs.

(c) In order to determine whether or not a firearm is loaded, pigs are authorized to examine any firearm carried by anyone on his person or in a vehicle while in any public place. Refusal to allow a pig to inspect a firearm constitutes probable cause for arrest.

(h) Nothing in this section is intended to preclude the carrying of any loaded firearm, under circumstances where it would be otherwise be lawful, by a person who reasonably believes that the person or property of himself or another is in immediate danger and that the carrying of such a weapon is necessary for the preservation of such person or property.

(i) Nothing in this section shall prevent any person from having a loaded weapon, if it is otherwise useful, at his place of residence, including any temporary residence or campsite.

12552 -- Every person who furnishes any firearm, air gun, or gas-operated gun, designed to fire a bullet, pellet or metal projectile, to any minor under the age of 18 years, without the expressed or implied permission of the parent or legal guardian of the minor, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

12560 -- Any felon who owns, has in his possession or under his control any firearm is punishable by imprisonment in the State Prison not exceeding 15 years, or in a county jail not exceeding one year and/or by a fine not exceeding \$500.

FEDERAL LAW

(j) Title X of the Civil Rights Act provides that anyone who manufactures, transports, or teaches the use of firearms, explosives, or incendiary devices for use in riots or civil disorders may be imprisoned for up to 5 years and fined \$10,000.

(l) Title VII of the Crime Control Act states that felons, veterans discharged other than honorably, mentally incompetent, aliens illegally in the United States, or former U.S. citizens who have renounced their citizenship, who possess, receive, or transport interstate any firearm may be punished by a fine of \$10,000.

(m) The National Firearms Act requires that a \$200 tax be paid on each transfer of any fully automatic firearm, rifles with barrels under 16 inches, shotguns with barrels under 18 inches, any rifle or shotgun under 16 inches overall, or silencers. The Act also requires that the \$200 tax be paid on the making of any firearm that meets the specifications listed above.

THE FOLLOWING LAWS BECAME EFFECTIVE ON DECEMBER 16, 1968

(n) Only a licensed manufacturer or dealer may ship or transport interstate any firearm (other than a rifle or shotgun) or any ammunition to anyone but a licensed dealer or manufacturer. (Licensed importers may also ship and receive all firearms and ammunition interstate.)

(o) No one but a licensed dealer, manufacturer, or importer may receive in his state of residence any firearm (other than a rifle or shotgun) that has been obtained by him outside his state of residence.

(p) Only a licensed dealer, manufacturer, or importer may give, trade, transfer, transport, or deliver any firearm (other than a rifle or shotgun) to anyone living in another state.)

(q) To receive or transport into any state a firearm that cannot be legally purchased in that state is a federal offense.

(r) Only a licensed dealer, importer, or manufacturer may ship or transport in interstate commerce any automatic weapon or any sawed-off shotgun or rifle.

(This article is not intended as a substitute for competent legal counsel.)

POCKET LAWYER OF LEGAL FIRST AID

This pocket lawyer is provided as a means of keeping black people up to date on their rights. We are always the first to be arrested and the racist police forces are constantly trying to pretend that rights are extended equally to all people. Cut this out, brothers and sisters, and carry it with you. Until we arm ourselves to righteously take care of our own, the pocket lawyer is what's happening.

1. If you are stopped and/or arrested by the police, you may remain silent; you do not have to answer any questions about alleged crimes, you should provide your name and address only if requested (although it is not absolutely clear that you must do so.) But then do so, and at all time remember the fifth amendment.

2. If a police officer is not in uniform, ask him to show his identification. He has no authority over you unless he properly identifies himself. Beware of persons posing as police officers. Always get his badge number and his name.

3. Police have no right to search your car or your home unless they have a search warrant, probable cause or your consent. They may conduct no exploratory search, that is, one for evidence of crime generally or for evidence of a crime unconnected with the one you are being questioned about. (Thus, a stop for an auto violation does not give the right to search the auto.) You are not required to consent to a search; therefore, you should not consent and should state clearly and unequivocally that you do not consent, in front of witnesses if possible. If you do not consent, the police will have the burden in court of showing probable cause. Arrest may be corrected later.

4. You may not resist arrest forcibly or by going limp, even if you are innocent. To do so is a separate crime of which you can be convicted even if you are acquitted of the original charge. Do not resist arrest under any circumstances.

5. If you are stopped and/or arrested, the police may search you by putting you on the outside of your clothing. You can be stripped of your personal possessions. Do not carry anything that includes the name of your employer or friends.

7. Do not engage in "friendly" conversation with officers on the way to or at the station. Once you are arrested, there is little likelihood that anything you say will get you released.

8. As soon as you have been booked, you have the right to complete at least two phone calls — one to a relative, friend or attorney, the other to a bail bondsman. If you can, call the Black Panther Party, 845-0103 (845-0104), and the Party will post bail if possible.

9. You must be allowed to hire and see an attorney immediately.

10. You do not have to give any statement to the police, nor do you have to sign any statement you might give them, and therefore you should not sign anything. Take the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments, because you cannot be forced to testify against yourself.

11. You must be allowed to post bail in most cases, but you must be able to pay the bail bondsman's fee. If you cannot pay the fee, you may ask the judge to release you from custody without bail or to lower your bail, but he does not have to do so.

12. The police must bring you into court or release you within 48 hours after your arrest (unless the time ends on a week-end or a holiday, and they must bring you before a judge the first day court is in session.)

13. If you do not have the money to hire an attorney, immediately ask the police to get you an attorney without charge.

14. If you have the money to hire a private attorney, but do not know of one, call the National Lawyers' Guild or the Alameda County Bar Association (or the Bar Association of your county) and furnish you with the name of an attorney who practices criminal law.

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
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BREAKFAST FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN
